5.0	Agency Finance	Update Agency Strategic Plan per Revised Budget	Once the Governor’s budget is complete and submitted to the General Assembly, agencies review the budget to see what is being recommended for funding and what is not. Agency Strategic Plans are then modified to include only those programs and efforts that are funded.
5.1	General Assembly	Governor’s Budget Received and Modified	During the General Assembly session, the Governor’s Budget goes through an involved process of review, modification, and approval, as the General Assembly prepares the budget for the upcoming biennium which is called the Appropriation Act.
5.2	General Assembly	Approve Biennium Budget/Draft Appropriation Act	Once the General Assembly settles on the budget, they submit the proposed budget or Appropriation Act to the Governor for signature.

Process ID	Owner	Process	Description
5.3	Governor	Sign Appropriation Act	After a period of negotiations between the Governor and General Assembly, the Governor signs the Appropriation Act and it becomes law. Typically, this occurs at the end of April.
