Cost Components

- Financial
 - Little or none with most deployments, but cost does increase with enhancements
- Operational
 - Impact to workstations
 - Training
 - Interfaces
- Political
 - Develop a case for change



Staff Recommendations

- Encourage the pursuit of web browser Text to 9-1-1 solutions
 - Greatest flexibility to support future messaging capabilities
- Leverage aggregator solutions to identify options for a statewide solution
 - Enhanced capabilities
 - PSAP Grant Program to help offset onetime costs
- Plan for integrated statewide deployment of Texting to 9-1-1 with NG9-1-1
 - Capturing data with NG9-1-1 Feasibility Study
