Total Project Cost \$37,953.00

Statement of Need:

Lunenburg County is a rural area and is economically challenged and has been affected by recent economic cutbacks. This upgrade is needed to to offer county citizens a high level of public service. Our current Mapping server and PC's are about seven years old and are no longer covered under a maintenance contract through the manufacturer. Our mapping system is vital to the response of emergency services to the citizens of Lunenburg County.

Comprehensive Project Description:

Goals of this project will be to replace our mapping server and two present mapping stations the and addition of one additional mapping postion. In addition the Tablet GIS system would provide the County to make changes to maps and provide enhanced mapping support to county citizens and emergency responders. Current changes made to our mapping system take approximatley 3 months to impliment from the time changes are made, but with the TabletGIS system changes are immidiate. If funding is received , project completion would be within 60 days of receiving funding. The new equipment is compatible with all of our present equipment and is compatible with new and upgraded equipment. The equipment purchased will support future technologies by being able to interface with future equipment and provide mapping support to surrounding counties.

How will the equipment purchased will support future technologies for PSAP readiness?:

The new equipment is compatible with all current on site equipment and compatible with future equipment and software upgrades.

Budget and Budget Narrative:

Grant funds will be distributed as described in the proposal from MSAG.

Evaluation:

Project will be evaluated by the purchase of the equipment, installation, performance of the equipment and being able to provide enhanced services to our community. It is also important for Lunenburg County to keep up with technological changes.
