Statement of Need:

These items need to be replaced due to age and breakdowns.

Comprehensive Project Description:

These are our 911 phone workstations for the purpose of answering emergency calls. This equipment has not been updated for over five years and is becoming old and is beginning to have problems with breakdowns. If this funding is not provided we can only repair items, as they are needed. This upgrade should hold us for another five years at least.

How will the equipment purchased will support future technologies for PSAP readiness?:

All equipment will be maintained and supported by a maintenance agreement with the phone company or try to find funding to repair it. This maintenance agreement does not cover all replacement of items.

Budget and Budget Narrative:

Goal is to have as modern equipment as we can in our PSAP for our dispatchers to better serve the public. Implementation and accomplishments of installing this equipment will be no more than 6 months after notification of award of grant.
