Statement of Need:

This grant request would satisfy a need by creating an additional phone (call-taking) position to use during

heavy call-load periods and disasters.

Comprehensive Project Description:

This project would provide a fourth Vesta phone position in an office adjacent to the dispatch floor. The phone position would be next to a CAD position, allowing the use of this position (answering 9-1-1 calls and entering incidents into the CAD) during heavy call-load periods or during disasters. After utilizing the appropriate mechanisms for procurement, the Vesta phone position will be purchased, installed, and tested during the upcoming fiscal year.

How will the equipment purchased will support future technologies for PSAP readiness?:

Our current CPE is the Vesta Pallas and this new phone position would become part of our existing phone system.
