Statement of Need:

In 2003 the state police conducted a safety and security assessment of the 9-1-1 Center. Although this

document was produced five years ago, very little has changed (in regards) to the facility and generally the recommendations continue to apply in 2008. Funding of this request would allow the addressing of many of the recommendations indicated in this report. It also will provide additional protection to our workstations, server, and network with additional virus and spyware protections.

Comprehensive Project Description:

This project includes two components. The first aspect addresses many of the recommendations in the state police safety and security assessment. Many of the doors (outside access and inside) are in need of improvements to promote a secure 9-1-1 Center. In addition, security concerns related to windows and generator access are addressed in the assessment and in the grant request. This project would address needs to five entry/egress doors, three inside doors, various windows, and the fuel supply for the generator. The second aspect of this project relates to additional IP/Internet security. The grant would allow the purchase of hardware providing content filtering and application blocking solutions and includes protection against Internet threats.

How will the equipment purchased will support future technologies for PSAP readiness?:

The additional security for the PSAP promotes the readiness and sustainability of the 9-1-1 Center.
