Statement of Need:

Presently law enforcement 9-1-1 calls transferred to the sheriff office dispatchers have no data attache dto

them when the transfer is completed. Be allowing the sheriffs offices to review ANI/ALI this would, at least, allow them to have some of the information/data available at the 9-1-1 Center.

Comprehensive Project Description:

ANI/ALI Fax - Equipment would be located at the ESVA 9-1-1 Center. Both sheriff offices will need a fax on the other end. 9-1-1 calls coming into our center with ANI/ALI will have the ability to fax that information to any location (sheriffs offices) that has a fax machine on the other end. There is no ongoing discussion of any consolidation of services, related to law enforcement dispatch, in either Accomack or Northampton County. This would attempt to provide law enforcement dispatchers with additional information.

How will the equipment purchased will support future technologies for PSAP readiness?:

Although this technology may be replaced in the future (with any consolidation or NG 9-1-1), it presently would assist in the delivery of ANI/ALI information.

Budget and Budget Narrative:

The budgetary cost for this is \$10,670 (includes a percentage increase for future cost changes). It includes equipment installation and programming and one year warranty.

Evaluation:

Once installed, this product be used frequently and tested regularly.
