Statement of Need:

Replace CAD system that is no longer being developed and continued support will become limited or non-existent in the future.

Comprehensive Project Description:

Replace CAD system that is no longer being developed and continued support will become limited or non-existent in the future. This project will include necessary procurement practices and will be procured and installed as soon as possible after notification of the grant award.

How will the equipment purchased will support future technologies for PSAP readiness?:

Would prefer a system that supports data sharing with neighboring jurisdictions, CAD to CAD dispatch, mobile CAD, alpha paging, and RMS interface. A system that is upgradable would be preferred.

Budget and Budget Narrative:

A quote has not been obtained at this time as I have been working with my vendor to determine their product and support termination date. Please note that there are no local funds available to support this acquisition and this projected is based solely on receipt of this grant. If the total project cost comes in at less the the amount requested additional funds may be applied to a multi year maintenance contract or returned to VITA. Please note that I am applying for two seperate grants, one for CPE and one for CAD. Our CAD vendor has indicated that they will no loger be developing our product and that support for our

existing product may be limited. I realize that current rules allow for only one grant application per grant period from a PSAP but I am respectfully requesting a variance from that practice. If only one project can be funded the CPE project takes priority.

Evaluation:

Post installation system checks to determine full system functionality prior to payment for equipment.
