Statement of Need:

Charlotte County has identified an issue with keeping the time synchronized on all computer applications in the 9-1-1 Center. There have been numerous occasions when the recorded or stamped times on various software components have differed. For example, the CPE may display one time, while the recorder or CAD system may display a different time. Purchasing and installing a NetClock on these devices or components will allow time synchronization and more reliable data.

Comprehensive Project Description:

The County will obtain a final quote for a NetClock to be purchased and installed in the facility. The proper devices and components will be connected to the NetClock in order to provide valuable time synchronization.

How will the equipment purchased will support future technologies for PSAP readiness?:

The NetClock will add a valuable addition to current equipment and applications. All future technologies or devices will be incorporated onto the NetClock.

Budget and Budget Narrative:

Charlotte County will proceed with obtaining final quotes once the grant funding is awarded and prior to

draw down. The County will coordinate the purchase and installation through the vendor after July 1, 2009. The project will be complete within the 12 month fiscal year.

Evaluation:

The project will be implemented and evaluated by verifying that all devices are properly in sync after installation. The County will continue to monitor the system on a routine basis.
