Statement of Need:

Halifax County currently utilizes the PlantCML RescueStar for customer premise equipment. The CPE is 5 years old and in current need for upgrades to improve performance and functionality. The CPE is stable and there have been no major issues or failures during operation. However, new upgrades will ensure continued success and operations.

Comprehensive Project Description:

Halifax County recognizes the need to keep the CPE equipment updated in order to effectively process 9-1-1 calls. The proposed project will ensure that the County is utilizing the most current software and hardware. The County intends to coordinate the upgrades through Embarq by replacing workstations for the current 5 position 9-1-1 Center. The upgrades will also include replacing the SMART software, Sentinel Stats and adding two SEALI servers. These upgrades will allow the County to take advantage of added features such as automatic rebids.

How will the equipment purchased will support future technologies for PSAP readiness?:

The CPE upgrades will support current and future technology available to 911 call delivery today.
