Statement of Need:

The County currently uses the Dictaphone Freedom recorder which is no longer supported through NICE Systems. The County will need additional channels for the recorder due to added interoperability projects. Based on the age and need for expansion, the County needs to replace the current Freedom recorder with a new system.

Comprehensive Project Description:

The County has received budgetary pricing for a new voice recorder. The goal for this project is to purchase newer equipment that can be maintained and supported while also offering the opportunity to expand.

How will the equipment purchased will support future technologies for PSAP readiness?:

A new voice recorder with additional channels will allow the County to record and archive current and future lines and frequencies.

Budget and Budget Narrative:

The County has received budgetary pricing for a new voice recorder and the quote will be submitted. Once the grant is approved and awarded, the County will follow local procurement laws to select a vendor and purchase the equipment.
