Electronic Medical Records:



- The DOC provides complete medical care, dental and vision for offenders
- We could fill a warehouse with paper medical records
- 95% of our offenders return to the community most with mental or health care issues
- Streamline health care for offenders. Will enforce same medical practices across institutions.
- Can share medical data with physicians once they have been released.
- Improve care based on the analysis of data
- Medical practitioners can become more mobile.

Electronic Medical Records:



- Challenges

- Have over 48 institutions across the state
- Have approximately 30K offenders
- Have years of paper medical records
- Cost and Time of implementation
- Adoption by medical staff

 SNAP - Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program
- Cash Assistance -
 TANF - Temporary Assistance for Needy Families
- Energy Assistance
 Fuel, Crisis, Cooling, & Weatherization
- Child Care Services

VirginiaCORIS &



- Process and workflow for eligibility & enrollment
- Create & submit Eligibility Requests systematically from VirginiaCORIS
- Receive Benefit Eligibility Responses from eHHR (realtime – near realtime)
- eHHR to capture source of requests for VCRI for social workers
- Provide benefit eligibility report to offenders from VirginiaCORIS
- Offenders or Counselors can register offenders for eligible benefits online
