HISTORY

Triggers

- American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA)
 - Funding for HIE/RECs via ONC grants
 - Funding for provider incentive program for adopting certified electronic health record systems via state Medicaid
 - Funding for technology needed by state Medicaid to support HIT
- Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act (PPACA)
 - Virginia uses the Federally Facilitated Marketplace (FFM) solution
 - Replacement of the legacy Eligibility and Enrollment Systems was needed to meet CMS' seven conditions and standards for enhanced funding
 - Enterprise services established by VDH for birth, death, and immunization registries

HISTORY

eHHR Program

- Established at the HHR Secretary level to
 - Adopt Medicaid IT Architecture (MITA) for vision and concept of operations
 - Strategic alignment between Federal and State efforts
 - Maximized federal funding assistance
 - HITSAC was a key partner in the effort
 - Program Oversight committee (POC)
 - Co-chaired by Secretaries Hazel and Duffy (prior administration)
 - Coordinate multi-agency projects across multiple projects and partners
 - VITA, VDH, DMV, DMAS, DSS
 - First program office established in executive branch agencies
 - eHHR Program was the model for the current state program office standards
 - Was awarded a Governor's Technology Award from COVITS in 2012 in cross-boundary collaboration on IT initiatives

Memory Lane Snapshots

- First HITSAC presentation: January 2011
 - Medicaid IT Architecture (MITA) state self-assessment (SSA) in progress to include Behavioral Health SSA.
 - Program office work groups were meeting
 - Outreach to HITSAC as a partner to establish standards for interoperability
 - Funding request document preparation in progress
 - Authentication efforts initiated with DMV
 - Technical infrastructure efforts initiated with VITA

Memory Lane Snapshots

- HITSAC presentation: June 2011
 - HIT funding approved effective 6/9/2011
 - Began funding technical infrastructure effort at VITA
 - Began funding Commonwealth Authentication Service (CAS) at DMV
 - Began funding HITSAC support staff at VITA
 - Began funding request for MITA Care Management Area projects
 - Birth, Death, and Immunization Registry Interface projects
 - Began framing up procurement to replace the legacy eligibility and enrollment (E&E) systems (DSS/DMAS)
 - CMS approved RFP for the provider incentive program

Memory Lane Snapshots

- HITSAC presentation: March 2012
 - eHHR Program initiatives
 - HHR IT Strategic Plan approved
 - First secretariat level IT Strategic plan in Virginia
 - Data sharing committee
 - Ongoing effort evolved into what is now called the Enhanced Memorandum of Understanding (EMOU)
 - Working on funding for MITA Care Management Projects
 - RFP for replacing E&E Legacy systems soon to be released
 - Included a state-based exchange option
 - Provider incentive program contracts were being wrapped up

 - Funding in place for HIT and E&E efforts

 - Projects (efforts started January 2013)
 - MAGI
 - Conversion
 - Program Migration
 - Provider incentive program launched (August 1, 2012)

 - Working the EMOU with the OAG
 - E&E projects
 - MAGI – Implemented on 10/1/2013
 - First open PPACA enrollment period; Virginia met the mandate
 - Conversion
 - Program Migration
 - Phase I Medicaid
 - » Document management solution
 - » ABD/LTC functionality
 - eHHR Program transition planning started
 - Mission needs to change as projects complete

Memory Lane Snapshots

- HITSAC presentation: February 2015
 - FFM/HIM open enrollment ended 2/15/15
 - Second year went well overall
 - No major technology problems
 - » FFM or COV
 - Active initiatives
 - EMOU Coordinating Committee continues regular meeting
 - Effort on cost sharing and reuse (must meet federal CAP) methodology for technical infrastructure and services continued
 - eHHR Program transition planning continued
 - Collaboration on enterprise data analytics

Eligibility Modernization

Project Status

- Program Migration Project
 - Phase I – Deployed labor day weekend
 - Included Medicaid ABD/LTC and other aid categories that have never been automated
 - Included asset verification system and document management
 - Medicaid related enhancements targeted for December 21, 2015
 - Some enhancements were reassigned to later releases
 - Phase II – first quarter 2016 on schedule
 - Includes TANF, SNAP, and LIHEAP
