Purpose

- CIO has code-mandated responsibility to maintain the COV Strategic Plan for IT
- Present VITA's approach



Technology Business Plan Initiatives

Initiative 1 – Emphasize programs and tools that enable all citizens to interact with government 24x7 – safely and securely, and when, how and where they want it

Initiative 2 – Improve information sharing to optimize current business functions and supporting systems

Initiative 3 – Leverage technology to improve worker productivity and make state employment more attractive to the future workforce

Initiative 4 – Support educational attainment initiatives - key to achieving state economic development and quality of life goals

Initiative 5 – Expand and support back-office platforms and productivity tools that support Governor's Reform Commission recommendations on streamlining government operations



Proposed Approach

- Timeframe: Six years (three biennia)
- Use ITAC Technology Business Plan initiatives as starting point
- Identify emerging technologies that support the ITAC initiatives
- Develop IT strategic directions to guide and govern deployment of emerging technologies
- Review with business leadership
- Post on ORCA for comment



Proposed Schedule

Task	Schedule
Identify strategic IT directions and emerging technologies: dialogue with VITA	November 2012
Identify strategic IT directions and emerging technologies: dialogue with agency stakeholders	December 2012
Develop initial draft	December 2012- January 2013
Circulate initial draft for comment	January – February 2013
Refine draft	February – March 2013
Proposed “Emerging IT Trends Symposium;” release refined draft; post on ORCA	March 2013
Incorporate comments, obtain approval and post plan	April 2013



Engaging Agency Business, IT Leaders

- Possibly conduct small group brainstorming session(s) in December with agency business and IT leaders
- Promote response to draft plan
- Encourage participation in proposed Symposium on Business Implications of Emerging IT Trends



Proposed Symposium Goals

- Offer agency business leaders insight into emerging IT trends likely to impact their business (bring in subject matter experts)
- Provide IT strategic directions for agency business and IT leaders to guide their evaluation and adoption of emerging technologies
- Venue to present final draft of updated Commonwealth Strategic Plan for IT
