ITAC Created to Represent Business

- ITAC created as advisory council or “formal liaison” between VITA & the secretariats
 - Ensure VITA understands customer concerns
 - Communicate VITA’s activities to customers
- ITAC reflects JLARC call for business leaders to provide strategic advice
 - Identify & communicate state’s business goals & priorities
 - Communicate how IT can address these business needs



ITAC Assigned Specific Responsibilities

- ITAC's powers & duties include advising CIO on:
 - Strategies, standards, & priorities for use of IT
 - Assessing & meeting business needs through use of IT
 - Prioritization, development, & implementation of enterprise-wide technology applications
 - Infrastructure expenditures, including annual review of all agency IT applications budgets
 - Development of IT applications governance framework



Statutory Changes in 2013 Session

- ITAC shall elect chair & vice-chair annually
 - Neither Secretary of Technology nor the CIO may be chair
- Meetings are called by chair, the Secretary, CIO, or majority of members
 - Quarterly meetings no longer required
